

5 Rules for keeping your cat “ in the box”

“Vets Your Pets Would Choose”

1. Scoop the litter box twice daily – all stool, all urine
2. Make the storage tote type box with lower lip no higher than 3 inches - box minimum 16 inches tall, 20 inches long, 14 inches wide (see youtube channel [drsallyjfoote](https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCsallyjfoote) for best litterbox video)
3. Use charcoal, unscented litter by Purina – only enough to cover the bottom of the box. Add new after scooping
4. Keep the box in a quiet, low traffic area that is easy for the cat to get to. For older cats, keep it on the main floor with plenty of head space
5. Have a veterinary check up annually, and note if your cat is changing how they get up to perches and where they lay. Pain is common for litterbox problems
